#### **Chateau Ste.Michelle - Dr.Loosen "Erioca" Riesling 2007** ~ This latest rendition from


Chateau Ste. Michelle and Ernst Loosen is a remarkable wine of impeccable balance and stunning depth. Slightly sweet and buoyed by fine fruity acids, it smells of honeysuckle, white peaches and minerals and follows with long, compact, layered flavors that presently only hint at the richness to come.

**Food suggestion:** Try this the next time you are in the mood for spicy Asian foods.

#### **Meandro do Vale Meão 2005 #64 Top 100**

"Powerful aromas and flavours of cassis, mint, dark chocolate and spice are accented by an impressive minerality. Medium-grained tannins and plenty of structure back up the almost Port-like essence of this muscular red. Shows exotic Asian spice notes on the finish. Drink now through 2012.

**Food suggestion:** Have you tried to "cold smoke" a steak before? This wine has a great smoky note on the nose and palate, I tried mine with a smoked prime rib steak and it was awesome!!


